BISPYRIBAC-SODIUM PERMIT CONDITIONS

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- A **permit must be obtained** from the County Agricultural Commissioner for any use of pesticides containing **Bispyribac-sodium** in Yuba County.
- A **24 hour Notice of Intent** must be filed with the Yuba County Department of Agriculture prior to the application of pesticides containing Bispyribac-sodium.
- All Requirements of the Food and Agricultural Code and Title 3, California Code of Regulations that apply to the use of **restricted materials shall apply to the use of pesticides containing Bispyribac-sodium** under permit in Yuba County.

1. **No air application within 1 mile of walnut orchards.**

2. All applications must take place during daylight hours.

3. No applications may take place during low-level inversion conditions. Inversion conditions begin to diminish after a 3 degree F temperature rise from the morning low. They may return after a 5 degree F drop in temperature in the afternoon. Application would be possible after the morning temperature rise and application should cease after a 5-degree drop in temperature in the afternoon. Wind conditions, mentioned below, could mitigate these guidelines.

4. Applications must take place with a **minimum wind speed of at least 2 mph and not to more than 8 mph** as measured at a height of four feet above the ground. If sensitive crops or plants are downwind, extreme caution must be used under all conditions.

5. Use of a **smoke column**, or other method or device, shall be employed at the time and place of application to indicate temperature inversions and the direction and velocity of airflow.

6. For the duration of the application, the aerial applicator must have an individual on the ground at the site of application that shall monitor conditions and have the ability to waive off the application in the event that conditions are unfavorable for proper application.

7. Applicators shall maintain a **written log indicating air temperature, wind speed, and wind direction** prior to beginning the application, and to be recorded every tank refill or hourly whichever occurs first, for each day of application. This log shall be made available for review by the Agricultural Commissioner's staff upon request.

8. Pilots shall attend an educational session sponsored by a registrant of a Bispyribac-sodium product regarding proper application techniques.

9. Each aircraft that applies a Bispyribac-sodium product in Yuba County must be certified by a registrant of Bispyribac-sodium prior to performing any application in Yuba County.
