## PROPANIL II

### **SPECIAL PERMIT CONDITIONS FOR THE USE OF NON-EMULSIFIABLE FORMULATIONS OF PROPANIL BETWEEN ONE MILE (1) AND ONE-HALF (1/2) MILE OF PRUNES OR OTHER SENSITIVE CROPS**

**The requirements of the PERMIT CONDITIONS FOR THE USE OF PROPANIL NON-EMULSIFIABLE FORMULATIONS IN DESIGNATED AREAS OF YUBA COUNTY (Propanil 1) are included and apply to ALL applications of Propanil authorized under these special permit conditions.**

Air flow must be away from sensitive crops with a steady wind speed of not less than two (2) miles per hour or greater than ten (10) miles per hour. Adjust tank mix capacity as weather indicates since applications must cease if wind direction changes and blows towards sensitive crops.

A smoke column must be used throughout the entire application to assure proper monitoring of climatic conditions at the application site.

**WRITTEN LOG:** For each application made under these permit conditions, the applicator shall maintain a written log indicating:

#### **Air temperature - Wind speed - Wind direction.**

The applicator shall record this information prior to commencement of the application and with each tank refill, or hourly, whichever occurs first. The written records shall be retained by the applicator for one (1) year following the application date. Such records shall be made available to the Commissioner upon request.

**Prior to the application,** a written recommendation prepared by a licensed Pest Control Adviser shall be presented to the Commissioner, which indicates that there are no other feasible pest management alternatives.

The NOI must state that the application is going to be made between one (1) mile and one-half (1/2) mile of sensitive crops and that this is a “**Propanil 2 application**”.
