## PROPANIL III

### YUBA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE PERMIT CONDITIONS FOR NON-EMULSIFIABLE PROPANIL APPLICATIONS WITHIN ONE-HALF (1/2) MILE OF PRUNES OR OTHER SENSITIVE CROPS

1. In order to obtain a restricted materials permit to apply Propanil within one-half (1/2) mile of sensitive crops the **Certified Applicator** must:
  - A. **Prior to any application**, a written recommendation prepared by a licensed Pest Control Advisor shall be presented to the Commissioner, which indicates that there are no other feasible pest management alternatives.
  - B. Propanil applications are to be made only to those areas of the rice field that are identified in the licensed pest control advisor's written recommendation as being infested with weeds.

#### 2. **NOTICE OF INTENT PROCEDURES:**

The APPLICATOR shall submit a Notice of Intent (NOI) 24 hours prior to the start of the application.

**The NOI shall be in effect only for the indicated day of application, site and acreage provided.** If the application is not completed on the day indicated, then call and activate the NOI file number at the time conditions become favorable.

3. No application shall be made when the temperature exceeds 95 degrees Fahrenheit.
4. All requirements of the YUBA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE PERMIT CONDITIONS designated as **Propanil 1** and **Propanil 2** are attached and apply to each application of Propanil authorized under these **Propanil 3** – Permit Conditions.
