RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SUPPORTING THE DISSOLUTION OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 55 AND REQUESTING LAFCO CONSIDERATION OF A FEE WAIVER OR REDUCTION OF APPLICABLE FEES	))))))	RESOLUTION NO. <u>2026-53</u>
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WHEREAS, County Service Area No. 55 (“CSA”) was established on October 19, 1993, for the purpose of providing maintenance of road and drainage facilities and of a fire suppression water system for an Agricultura/Rural-Residential development consisting of seven (7) single family residential lots; and

WHEREAS, the CSA currently serves 7 parcels owned by the sole property owners within the service area boundaries; and

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2026, Gary Yarborough and Beverly Yarborough, the sole property owners within County Service Area 55, submitted a written request for dissolution of the CSA; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that dissolution of the CSA is appropriate and in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) has jurisdiction over the dissolution process; and

WHEREAS, County Service Area No. 55 lacks sufficient funding to support the costs associated with processing the dissolution request; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to support dissolution of the County Service Area No. 55 and request LAFCO consider a waiver and reduction, or other accommodation of applicable processing fees due to the lack of funding within the County Service Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yuba as follows:

1. Support the dissolution of County Service Area No. 55.
2. Authorize County staff to submit the necessary application materials and supporting documentation to the LAFCO for consideration of the dissolution.
3. Request that LAFCO consider a waiver or reduction of applicable fees associated with the dissolution request due to the lack of sufficient funding within the CSA.
4. Authorize County staff to take all actions necessary to facilitate processing of the dissolution request.
