Functions:	Provide leadership on issues which affect the quality of life for all older persons; to promote citizen involvement in planning; to deliver programs and services necessary to ensure maximum independence; and to promote dignity for older individuals and functionally impaired adults.
Qualifications:	Resident of Yuba County.
Terms:	Three-year term ending June 30.
Appointees:	Two (2)
Membership:	Total membership of the council is 35 consisting of appointees from the area plan which is seven counties: Nevada, Placer, Sacramento, Sierra, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba.
Meeting Info:	Third Thursday of each month at 1:00 p.m. at different locations with the counties represented. Requires an average of 6-10 hours commitment per month which includes preparation, travel time, general meetings, and committee work.
Compensation:	Mileage at the current IRS business rate.
