

PARTNERSHIP HEALTHPLAN OF CALIFORNIA COMMISSION

Purpose: Improving health care access to Medi-Cal recipients, and improving Medi-Cal reimbursement rates to health care providers. The commission links each member with a primary care provider, which reduces the inappropriate use of emergency rooms, therefore providing appropriate levels of inpatient care, developing innovative case management programs and arranging for the provision of an enhanced level of local health care services.

Qualifications: Appoint one (1) Commission Seat appointment from:

1. Safety net providers (including federally qualified health centers)
2. Behavioral health providers
3. Regional center providers
4. Local education authorities
5. Dental providers
6. Indian health services facility providers
7. Hospital providers
8. As opportunity allows, select a candidate who reflect the diversity of the community and regions (race, ethnicity, language, and disability status)

Terms: 4 year terms

Appointees: One (1) 0-45,000 Medi-Cal beneficiaries within the county
