Whereas, the combined Yuba-Sutter roadway fatality rate is 18.74 per 100,000 people, significantly higher than the national rate of 11.7;

Whereas, The County of Yuba, along with its partners - Sutter County and the cities of Marysville, Live Oak, Yuba City, and Wheatland, are developing a regional safety action plan to address this unacceptably high rates of motor vehicle involved fatalities in the region;

Whereas, traffic deaths and serious injuries are a preventable public health issue that must be addressed;

Whereas, safety is a shared responsibility;

Whereas, The U.S. Department of Transportation awarded a “*Safe Streets for All*” grant to the County of Yuba and its partners to cover the costs associated with the development of a regional safety action plan; and

Whereas, the the U.S. Department of Transporation requires communities to adopt the “Vision Zero” goal and vision as part of a safety action plan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the Goal and Vision for the “Yuba-Sutter Regional Safety Action Plan” as follows:

Goal: *The Yuba-Sutter Region will work collaboratively to eliminate traffic fatalities and serious injuries by 2050.*

Vision: *The Yuba-Sutter Region will have a multimodal, sustainable, equitable transportation system where users of all ages and abilities can travel conveniently, reliably, and free from harm.*


