WHAT IS THIS STUDY ABOUT?

Yuba County Public Works is hosting an open house to share more about the ongoing culvert study. Yuba County and its consultant, R&F Engineering, are evaluating approximately culverts under County-owned and maintained rural roads for impacts due to climate change. The study will inventory existing culverts, assess their capacity, and help prioritize future culvert replacements where improvements are needed.
