2. Update from Yuba County Departments

- **County Administrator Updates** – Welcome Michelle White; District 3. Period Ending 13 added \$10,329 SO Jail Cameras/RIPPA Cell Phone (referencing MK Summary Revenue & Exp Summary Report page 2), and Linda Fire removed an expenditure that fell in FY 25-26, not FY 24-25. Motion for items to be approved: Lori, Second: Rich
- **Sheriff Updates – Animal Care Services (ACS)** calls for service, city of Marysville wheatland rabies cases whether animal bite or wildlife. Investigate. Respond to any need the public has regarding animals, wildlife, livestock. Housing animals. Handle after hours calls (uncommon for area). 24/7. FM: Personnel waiting at office, or on call? HN: On call from 6PM-7AM. 3 Full Time ACS officers split the month amongst each other. FM: avg. calls for services? HN: 20-30 calls per day. Severity and location vary.

Investigations of all types (animal cruelty, animal fighting, etc.) FM: primary investigative agency? HN: yes, partner with Sheriff operations. FM: who seeks prosecution of these cases? HN: partnership, typically operations takes the lead. All animals taken during animal cruelty cases, etc. become custody of Sheriff's Department and are housed on county site, or taken care of daily at original site until the case gets adjudicated. Presents challenge when it comes to space. Also take calls for wildlife kills; partner with County Trapper and Fish & Wildlife. Measure K funds – AC and roof on kennel, repaired walk in freezer, install cameras, upgrades to fencing to provide safety for animals and staff, automatic gates, purchased minor surgical equipment in hopes of being able to provide spay and neuter at ACS (currently utilizing outside county vets), purchased equipment for safe capture of animals, IT upgrades to new computer systems, 2 additional animal care tech positions S&B. FM: daily population? HN: 24 large kennels, quarantine kennels, (36 outdoor full capacity) pastures, barn. FM: volunteers? HN: Yes, STARS program and allocated volunteers. Will get more volunteers for vaccination clinics as needed. Board complimentary of ACS efforts.

- **Admin Services** – Explanation of what Admin Services handles (property, maintenance, Building & Grounds, building, IT, solar projects, utilities, fleet, surplus, etc.) B&G helped with HVAC and roof project at ACS completed in FY 24-25. Jolene handout of pictures of completed project. Measure K S&B in IT, Admin Analyst and Admin Tech in Admin Services – supports contracts and purchasing for safety. Board complimentary of the amount of work done and how fiscally responsible they were with the project. Enjoyed the pictures and explanations, appreciative of the time spent to present the projects.
