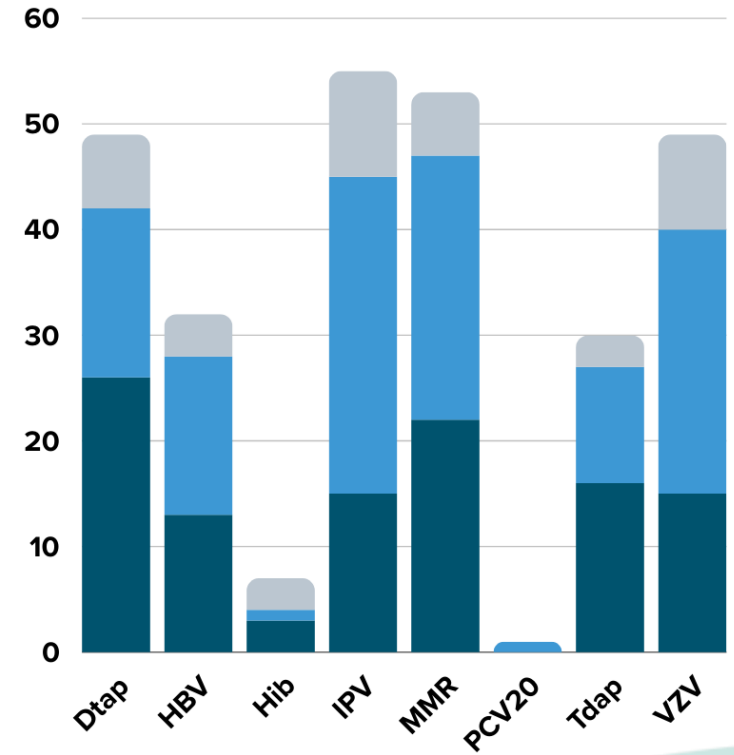
# Back-to-School Vaccines
