- Post Election Survey from Inspectors and Poll Workers for Statewide Special Election:
 - Karie requested to review the accessible questions on the survey. Here are the questions on the survey:
 1. Were the mitigation (handicap accessible) instructions clear and easy to understand?
 2. Did you have any accessible (disabled) voters use the ICX audio ballot? If yes, what assistance was needed?
 3. Were there any curb-side voters?
- New sites:
 - Yuba County Health and Human Services
 - Linda Fire Station 1
 - Camptonville
 - No mitigation issues at these new locations were identified in the most recent election.
- Continuing to update website in the Accessible area
 - Updates to accessible have been submitted to management for review and approval.
 - Will continue to update as needed

- Karie updated us on the Statewide Disability Hotline from previous election
 - 117 calls
 - 57% from disabled
 - 40% had 1 or more voting issues
 - VBM – 52 calls – mostly asking when ballot will arrive
 - 1 call for Yuba County was identified and had to do with a person unable to leave home to vote. I do recall we had a person that we delivered their ballot and returned their voted ballot to the election office.

- b. *Karie discussed that she would be able to review the Voter Resource page on the VIG for the upcoming elections.*
- c. *Karie also requested that we work with NorCal Services to see what ASL options might be available to help those voters with hearing disabilities.*
