

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF SCHOOL BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE
PLUMAS LAKE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026
AND NOTICE OF DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS
FOR OR AGAINST THE MEASURE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified electors of the Plumas Lake Elementary School District, located in the County of Yuba ("Yuba County") that in accordance with the provisions of the California Education Code, an election will be held on November 3, 2026, within the District, at which election the following measure shall be submitted to the qualified electors of District and voted upon:

"To construct/furnish a gymnasium, an essential component of the new Plumas Lake Junior High School, all prior components of which have been funded from builder fees and State funds and not from any tax burden on District property owners, shall the Plumas Lake Elementary School District issue \$9,000,000 in bonds at legal rates, annually levying approximately \$12 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation, generating approximately \$426,000 annually while bonds are outstanding, with strict accountability including audits and public spending disclosures?"

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN based on the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print arguments and county voter information guides, the Yuba County Clerk has fixed 5:00 p.m. on August 14, 2026, as the date after which no arguments FOR or AGAINST the measure may be submitted to the Yuba County Clerk's Office, 915 8th Street, Suite 107, Marysville, CA 95901. Visit "Local Measures" at www.yuba.gov/elections for information and the required forms for filing an argument.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to the California Elections Code, the governing board of the District, or a member or members of the governing board, or an individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or a combination of such voters and associations, may file a written argument for or against the measure. An argument shall not exceed 300 words in length.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that if arguments are submitted both for and against the measure, the authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not to exceed 250 words. The Yuba County Clerk has fixed 5:00 p.m. on August 21, 2026, as the deadline for submission of rebuttal arguments

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN polling sites will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on November 3, 2026.
