## IN-CUSTODY DEATH REPORTING PURSUANT TO PC 10008

When a person who is in custody dies, the agency with jurisdiction over the state or local correctional facility with custodial responsibility for the person at the time of their death shall, consistent with reporting requirements pursuant to Section 12525 of the Government Code, post all of the following on its internet website:

1. The full name of the agency with custodial responsibility at the time of death.  
Yuba County Sheriff's Office
2. The county in which the death occurred.  
Yuba County
3. The facility in which the death occurred, and the location within that facility where the death occurred.  
Yuba County Jail, D-pod
4. The race, gender, and age of the decedent.  
White, male, 39 years old
5. The date on which the death occurred.  
September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025
6. The custodial status of the decedent, including, but not limited to, whether the person was awaiting arraignment, awaiting trial, or incarcerated.  
Arrested 07-31-25, Arraignment
7. The manner and means of death.  
Pending investigation
