PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS:

1) **Waldo Road Bridge Replacement Project – Draft Environmental Impact Report:**

Session to receive public comment on the Partially Recirculated Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Waldo Road over Dry Creek Bridge Replacement Project. The original EIR was published in March 2025. Beale Air Force Base responded to the published EIR with a letter that identified new biological information regarding fish

presence in Dry Creek. As a result, the Biological Resources, Tribal Cultural Resources, and Mandatory Findings of Significance chapters of the EIR were revised and recirculated for public comment.

Staff Report: Kevin Perkins introduced the project and provided a PowerPoint presentation to discuss the history of the bridge and updated environmental findings for the proposed new bridge.

Public Hearing:

Commissioner Webb asked who was responsible for building the bridge. Kevin Perkins explained that because the County has right of way of the bridge, they will be building the new bridge. Commissioner Webb also asked if the historical bridge would be removed. Kevin Perkins confirmed that the historical bridge will be removed. He added that mitigation measures require a monument at the historic bridge site and a Public Works pamphlet, both detailing the bridge's history and significance.

Commissioner Knight asked if there were specifics on the timing of construction in relation to environmental findings. Amy Dunay with Dokken Engineering stated that there are a couple of seasonal windows that would require additional measures to be taken during construction. She explained that for example, from July to October, a water diversion plan was required to ensure that fish have a good run of water to flow through as studies have also found new habitat upstream. Commissioner Knight also asked about permits to begin construction. Kevin Perkins stated that multiple permits would be required and that the application and approval timelines for environmental permits could delay construction by a couple of years.
